Hemp vs. Cannabis: What's the Difference?

Hemp and cannabis are different varieties of the same plant species, *Cannabis sativa L*. Although they do share some similarities, the two plants have several key differences due to their biological structures.

^{**} Up to four cannabis plants can be grown at a primary private residence. It is legal to use cannabis in a private residence.
